

Supply List 2010-2011

PreK:

- change of clothes in a Ziploc bag with child's name on it
- water bottle
- Art supplies:
 - 1 box of cotton swabs
 - 1 old shirt to be worn during art (cut the sleeves if it looks like they will drag in art work)

Kinder:

- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- 1 package of wet wipes
- 1 paper towel tube
- 1 box of crayons-NO markers or colored pencils please
- 4 Elmer's brand glue sticks
- a plastic bag with the child's names and change of clothes inside (to remain at school)
- water bottle to bring to and from class
- a white t-shirt to be decorated and worn throughout the year on class field trips. Please write your child's name on the label in permanent marker. (It is a good idea to buy one a little larger than your child currently needs, to allow for growing room.)

 - 1 pkg. of colored pencils
 - 2 pencils with eraser tops
 - 1 black permanent marker
 - 1 hand held pencil sharpener

7th Grade:

- Book Sox-4 large and 2 small (no adhesive covers please)
- Graph paper (1/4 inch) for math and Science
- 2 dry erase markers-Algebra
- For first dance, one bag of chips and two 2-liter sodas; parents may wish to wait and send these in the week of the dance (usually Oct), which is fine.
